BYLAW NO. 8251

A Bylaw to amend Small Creature Limitation Bylaw No. 4123, 1970

The Council of the Corporation of the City of North Vancouver, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be known and cited for all purposes as “**Small Creature Limitation Bylaw 1970, No. 4213, Amendment Bylaw 2012, No.8251**” (allowing for hens in the city).

2. The bylaw is amended as follows:

i. by adding the following Section as **2: Keeping of Hens:**

“No person shall keep, harbour or permit to remain upon permitted premises within the City of North Vancouver more than eight (8) hens in aggregate”

“Hens shall be kept for personal use only, and eggs, manure, meat, and other products derived from hens shall not be sold”.

“The keeping of roosters is prohibited”

“Hens shall not be slaughtered or euthanized on the property. Hens shall only be disposed of by delivering to a farm, abattoir, veterinarian, or other facility that has the ability to dispose of hens lawfully”.

“The keeping of hens shall comply with all zoning requirements as per Zoning Bylaw No. 6700”

ii. by renumbering the remaining sections accordingly.

3. Effective Date:

This bylaw shall come into force and effect on the date of its enactment.

READ a first time by the Council on the 23rd day of July, 2012.

READ a second time by the Council on the 23rd day of July, 2012.

READ a third time and passed by the Council on the 23rd day of July, 2012.

RECONSIDERED and finally adopted by the Council, signed by the Mayor and City Clerk and sealed with the Corporate Seal on the 17th day of September, 2012.
