BYLAW NO. 8250

A Bylaw to amend Zoning Bylaw No. 6700, 1995

The Council of the Corporation of the City of North Vancouver, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw amendment shall be known and cited for all purposes as **“Zoning Bylaw 1995, No. 6700, Amendment Bylaw, 2012, No. 8250” (Hen Keeping in One-Unit Residential Zones)**.
2. “Zoning Bylaw, 1995, No. 6700” is hereby amended as follows:
 - a. In Division I: Part 2: Interpretation by adding the following new definition for “Accessory Hen Keeping”:

““Accessory Hen Keeping” means of keeping of hens subject the “Small Creature Limitation Bylaw, 2012, No. 8251” as amended from time to time;”;
 - b. In Division III: Part 5: Zone Standards Residential Zone Regulations, Section 501 (1) Uses in One-Unit Residential Zones, by adding the following after subsection (g):

“(h) Accessory Hen Keeping, with customarily incidental Accessory Structures subject to Section 412, and customarily incidental Accessory Buildings subject to Section 514 of this bylaw.”

READ a first time by the Council on the 23rd day of July, 2012.

READ a second time by the Council on the 17th day of September, 2012.

READ a third time and passed by the Council on the 17th day of September, 2012.

RECONSIDERED and finally adopted by the Council, signed by the Mayor and City Clerk and sealed with the Corporate Seal on the 17th day of September, 2012.
